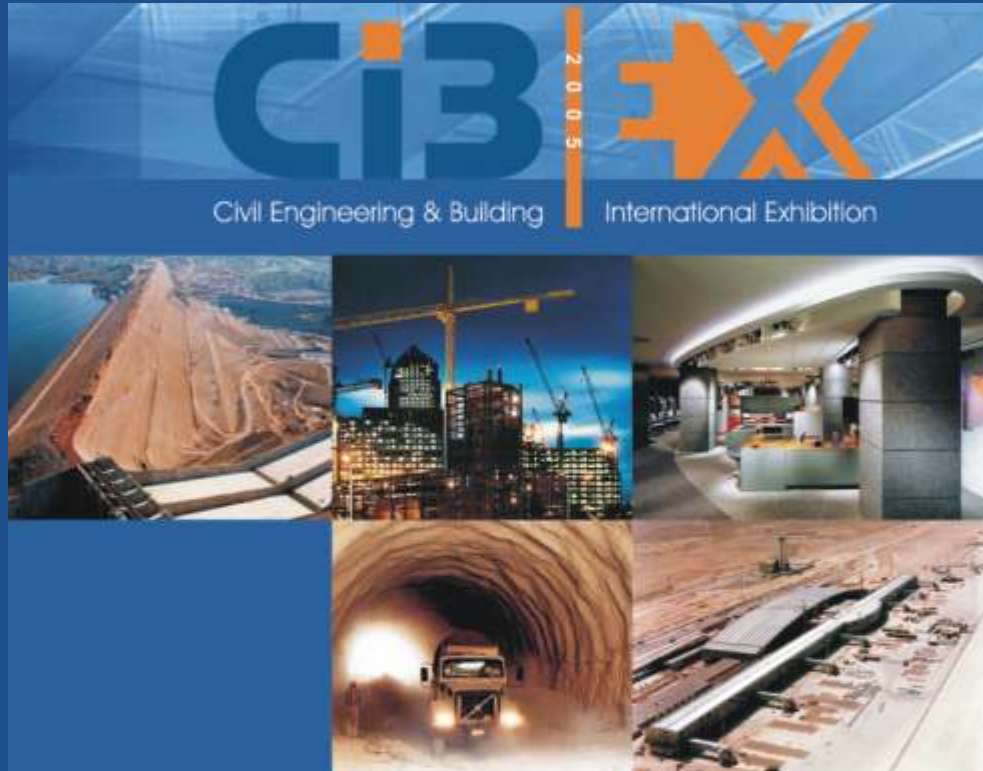

### Indoor Space

\*Shell Scheme: 180 US \$ per sqm.  
Each 12 sqm stand is equipped with surrounding partitions, carpeting, fascia bearing the company name, spotlights, one table, 2 chairs, electricity outlet (5 amp/220v single phase), one waste paper basket.  
Minimum allocatable space is 12 sqm.

\*Raw Stand Space: 140 US \$ per sqm.  
The organizer may provide exhibitors with a bare surface ( if requested ) and in this case the exhibitors are required to build at their own expenses.  
Minimum allocatable space is 30 sqm.

### Outdoor Space

\*Raw outdoor space: 70 US \$ per sqm.  
Minimum allocatable space is 20 sqm.

\*Temporary outdoor covered space: 120 US \$ per sqm.  
The organizer will provide the exhibitor a temporary outdoor covered stand. Each 20 sqm of this Kind of stand will include floor carpet, 4 chairs, one table, 5 lights (100w each), one 5 amp/220v single phase socket, one waste paper basket and fascia bearing the company name.  
Minimum allocatable space is 20 sqm.

### Terms of Payment

50% of the total charges should be paid before 17 March 2005 and the remaining balance before 24 April 2005.

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

### Application

- Acknowledging the rules and regulations, the application form will be completed by the Exhibitor and sent to the Exhibition Secretariat by 24 April 2005.

### Stand design & installation

- Exhibitors who wish to design and install their own stand, must submit the stand design to the Organizer 30 days prior to the exhibition. The Exhibitor must introduce a contractor for stand construction, who will be subject to Organizer confirmation. Installation will start upon the confirmation of the contractor and receipt of the deposit slip (for at least 50% of total charges).
- The Organizer reserves the right to make modifications in the design.
- The lay out of goods and stand decoration must be concluded 24 hours before inauguration and additional items and empty boxes removed from exhibition space.
- The Exhibitor will compensate the Organizer for damages made to exhibition buildings or any part or any of the fixtures and fittings, the amount to be decided upon by expert appraisal.
- The Organizer will arrange for the cleaning of outdoor and indoor areas.

### Safety & security

- Exhibitors are required to carry out necessary measures for safekeeping of their goods & precious exhibits against fire and other unpredicted events.
- Exhibitors must remove all inflammable materials including empty boxes and packaging material from the exhibition space and avoid keeping them upon the route of electricity cables or behind panels.
- Organizer will advise a space for the storage of unnecessary materials.
- The Exhibitor will be liable to damages sustained through his own action.
- Exhibitors are prohibited from storing naked lights or ignitable articles in the halls. Neither oil nor other types of fuel may be stored on the site.

### Vacating Exhibition Spaces

- Packing and gathering of exhibited goods must be concluded 1 day after the conclusion of exhibition.
- Exhibitors must vacate pavilions, stands and other installations and subsequently hand them over to the Organizer no later than 3 days after the conclusion of the exhibition.
- In the event an Exhibitor fails to vacate his pavilions after the specified date, the Organizer will vacate his pavilions and all expenses incurred hereby will be charged to the Exhibitor.
- The Exhibitor will be charged for storage expenses should there arise any dispute regarding the removal of goods from the exhibition area.
- The Organizer reserves the right to confiscate the disputed Exhibitor goods after one month if no liquidation has been made.
- The Organizer reserves the right to ask for balance payment in case damages sustained are deemed to be more than the value of the seized goods.

### Import & Export of goods (Customs affairs)

- Import of goods from the country of origin to Kish Island is licensed.
- Imported goods may only be moved out of Kish Island after submission of Customs Clearance Documents and the Air/ Marine Bill of Lading issued upon entering Kish.
- Exhibitors must inform the Exhibition Secretariat of the list of goods, their quantity, and weight in addition to the above items, no later than 15 days before moving them in.
- Transfer of goods to/from the Exhibition must be done according to the instructions of the Organizer.
- Exhibitors will take care of all costs pertaining to the shipment and clearance of goods from Customs and to the Exhibition venue.
- The Organizer will suggest a Forwarding & Customs contractor to Exhibitors.

### Official Catalogue

- The Organizer will publish an Official Catalogue dedicated exclusively to the Exhibition. The Exhibitor is required to provide entry information to be published in the Catalogue, at a maximum length of 300 characters.

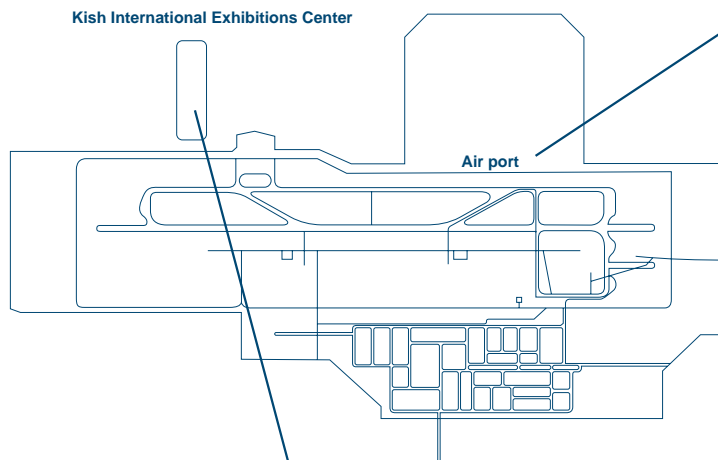
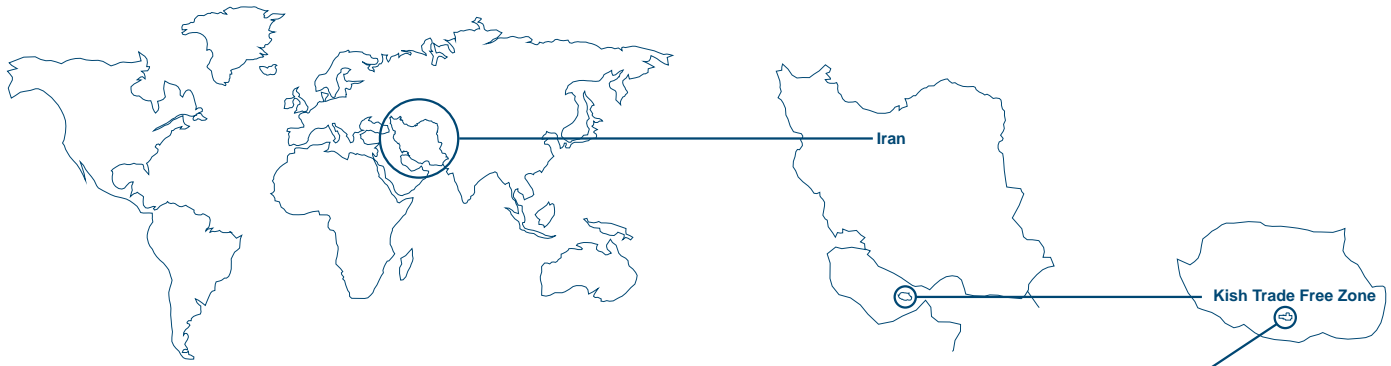
